Track Info	<p>When Music Box is selected, main screen will display track info (ie album, artist and title.)</p> <p>It will :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • read this directly off the CD, or • will search for them via an on board gracenote database, or • allow you to export the track list to the CF, so you can connect to your PC for updating, and import it back to the HD music box. <p>See: http://www.infiniti.com/music-update/</p>	<p>When the device is selected, main screen will display track info (ie album, artist and title) BUT ONLY if it exists as part of the file when it is copied to the media.
